
## How To Set Up A Gmail Account


## To Create Your Account:

- Click Create Account.




Choose a **strong password** — something that is hard for someone else to guess. Use capital letters, numbers, and special characters.

Next, enter your **phone number** to verify your account. Google uses a two-step verification process for your security.







You will receive a text message from Google with a **verification code**. **Enter the code** and click **Verify**.


Next, you will see a form to enter some of your personal information, like your name and birthday.


Review Google's Terms of


## Get Gmail on an iPhone:

Go to **Settings** and scroll down to choose **Accounts & Passwords**.


Choose Add Account.

Enter your email address, tap **Next**.




Enter your password, tap **Next**.




If you see a message about 2-step verification, follow the directions on the screen.
