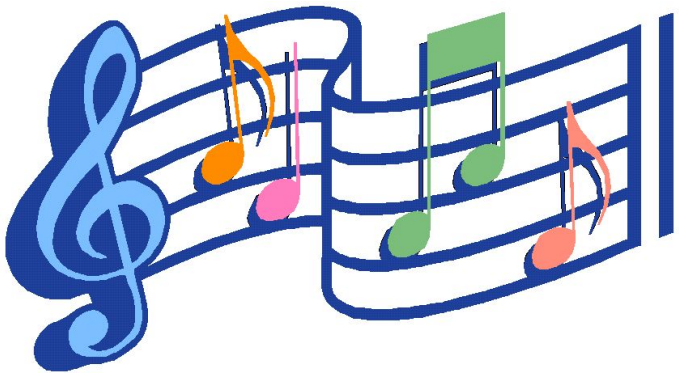

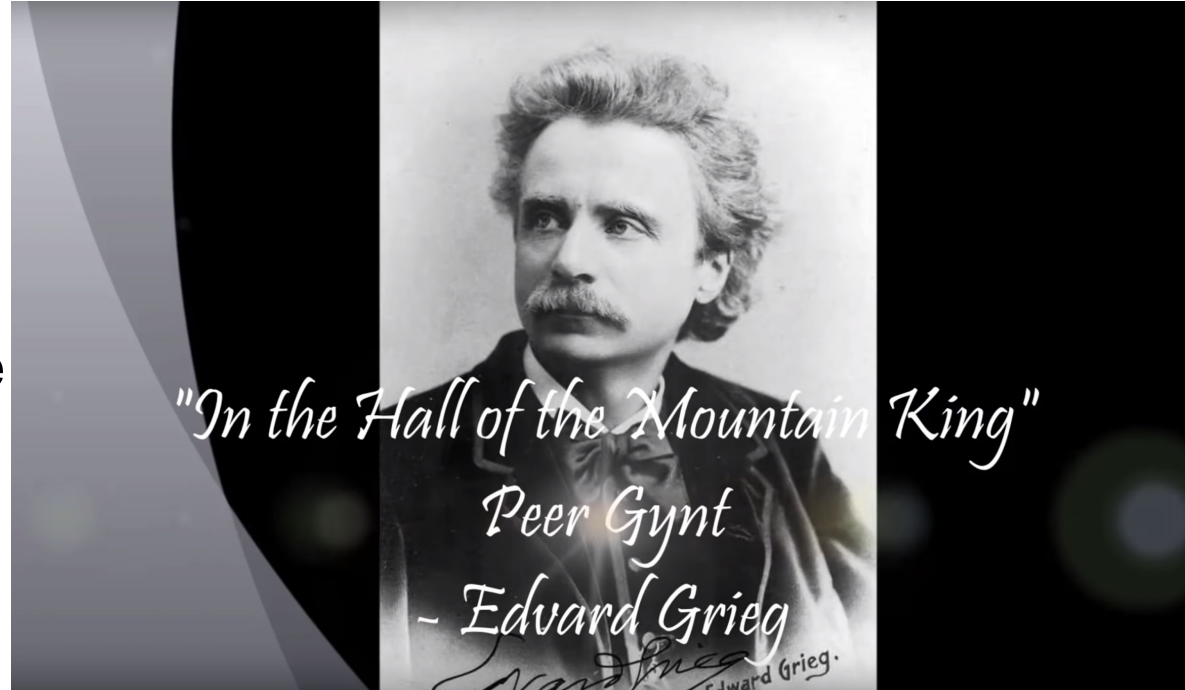

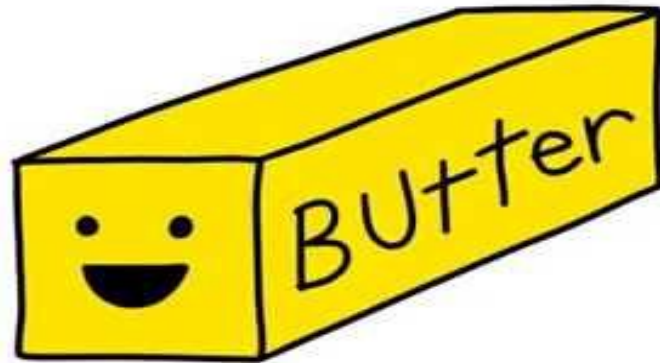


3. Listen, Watch & Sing!
